I have known Rich Cunnington close to 30 years and when I heard of his recent accident, I wanted to see what we could do to help him and his family. My brother-in-law have been arranging fundraising events in support of many local and national charities for over a decade now and we decided to work up a plan to provide support for Rich in this challenging time. We are working with Dan Claydon, another long time friend and colleague to Rich and we have devised the plan for **Roads for Rich**.

This year has been a difficult one for many and social distancing rules mean that we have to adapt our traditional plans to make sure everyone remains safe and secure throughout. So we have created a 145 mile continuous route around West and South Yorkshire broken down into stages of 2 to 13 miles. We invite people to register to join in family groups, bubbles or in socially distanced groups of friends. Our aim is to raise £15,000 to help Rich and his family adapt his house allow him to come home. Join us walking the **Roads for Rich**.

## Richard's story

The 29th of May was to be a day that Richard's life and the lives of all who know and love him would change forever.

Richard had always loved motorbikes, loved the ride but most especially the camaraderie with his mates that it brought him. The 29th was a day out with the fellas like any other but with a different ending....an ending that almost was the end.....period.

As with all things in life, it's the single moments in time that make the biggest changes...Richards involved a blind corner on a country road and two vehicles being in the wrong place at the wrong time. Simply put horrifically bad luck.

His injuries for the first few weeks were life threatening; multiple fractures of the pelvis and neck; ruptured bladder; fractured eye socket, an amputated right leg; not to mention he gave his "noggin" a good rattle; he was in a coma for many weeks and the outcome, after numerous surgeries was; needless to say, very uncertain.

Now 12 weeks later on the 22nd of August, we are so very relieved and happy to report that he is making a recovery that we could only have hoped for on that fateful day. With the unalterable outcome of a missing leg and; at this moment in time, a still healing pelvis with an uncertain future.



We are now faced with the challenge of making the house a safe and comfortable environment for Richard to come home to. Where he can; once discharged, enter his home and any room in it, ie; bedroom, bathroom, kitchen at full steam on his new set of two wheels.... his wheelchair (we may paint flames down the side or install a horn – beep! beep!)

With your help, our hope is to raise funds to aid in the cost of necessary alterations to the house. Alterations which will enable Richard to adjust with dignity to the “new normal”. Not having to worry about the basic things while adjusting to the 101 new ways of doing the “little things”. Installing ramps going into the house; the widening of doorways and lastly the installation of a wet room would make “home” possible. With all the comfort and recuperation that could bring.

We realize these are difficult times, for many families in many different situations due to COVID19 and all its complications; but from our family to yours – THANK YOU - whether it’s just taking the time to read this post and passing it on or being able to assist in our cause, it is and always will be truly appreciated.

# How the Event Works

## The Event

Due to the current pandemic, we have to rethink our traditional team plan. Social distancing rules mean that the rotating team model that Redwood Events have used in the past is not currently viable.

Our plan this time is simple. Our continuous 145 mile route is split into 20 stages of anything from 2 to 13 miles in length. We will invite walkers to register to walk in groups so that we have each of the stages covered.

Walkers will need to

- Register by buying a t-shirt (£10) and / or a hoodie (£15)
- Arrange their own transport to the start and from the end of their stage
- Ensure they walk in a socially distanced fashion aligned to the COVID rules in the community at the time (October 23-25)
- Try to raise a minimum of £100 in individual sponsorship – we will provide offline sponsor forms and set up a Crowdfunding Page for online donations

## Fundraising for Rich

Money will be raised in a number of ways

- Stage sponsors will be recruited for each of the 20 stages raising a minimum of £100 per stage
- All walkers will be asked to try to raise £100 each in personal sponsorship. A crowdfunding donation page will be set up for this
- Signed memorabilia will be collected from the clubs we visit which will be auctioned after the event
- Event T-shirts will be available at £10 with £2 for each sale going to our fundraising pot.
- Event hoodies will be available at £15 with £3 for each sale going to our fundraising pot.

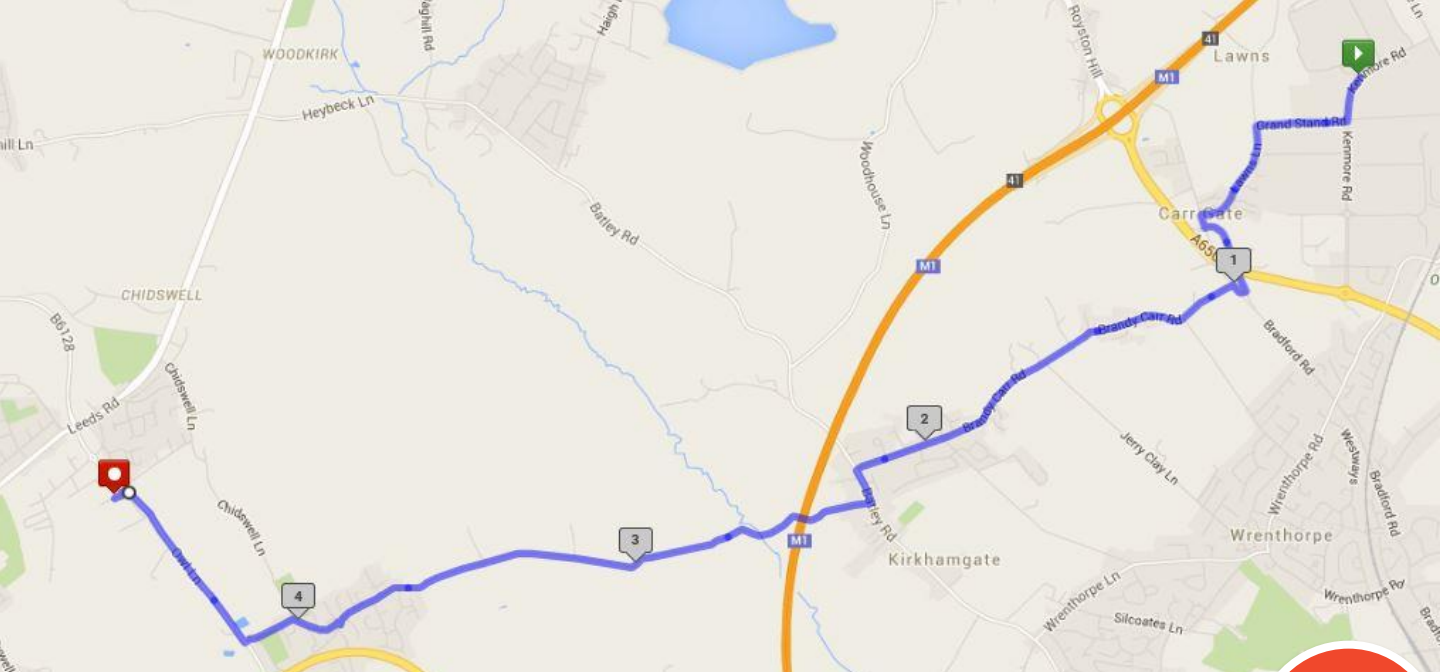

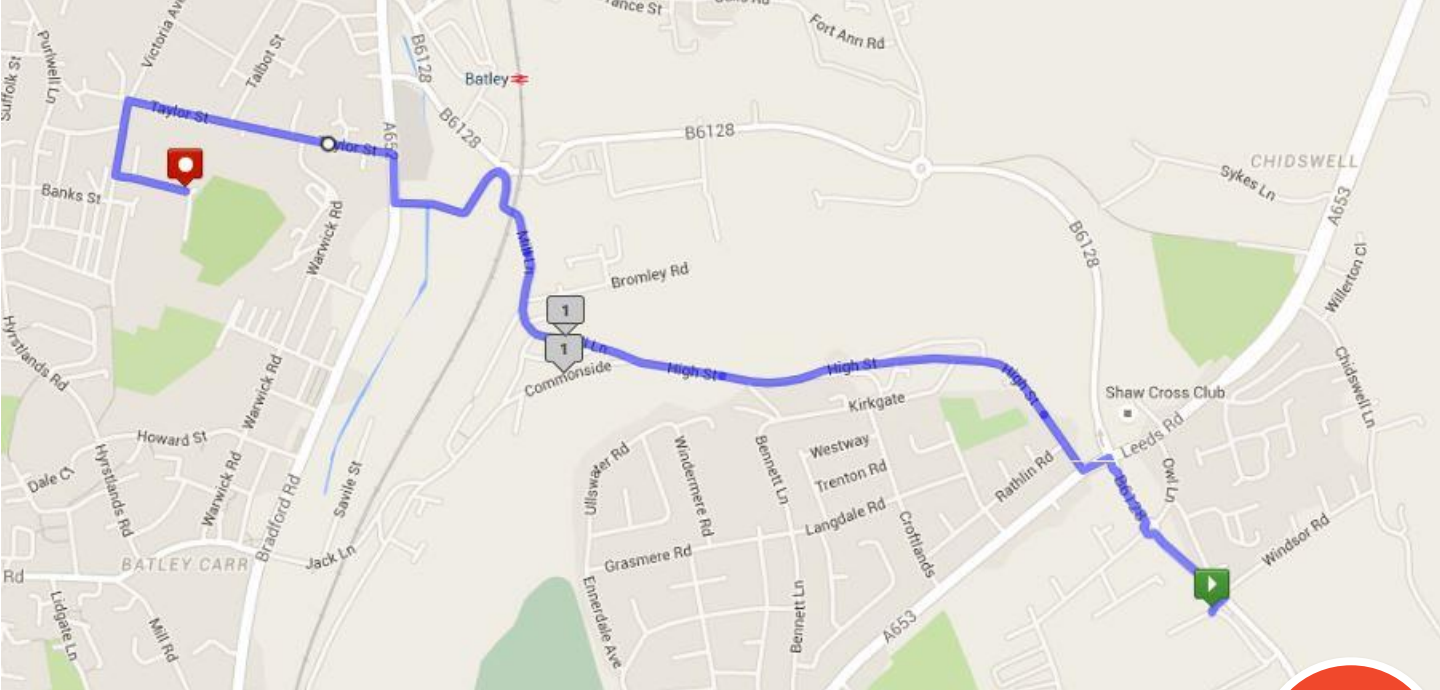


## Stage 1– Coca Cola to Dewsbury Rams

15

- 0.0 – Continue down Kenmore Road and take the first right on Grand Stand Road
- 0.3 – At the end, turn left on Lawns Lane
- 0.7 – At the end turn left on Bradford Road and immediately left again on Bradford Road at the next junction
- 0.9 – After crossing the bridge, turn acutely right and then take the first left down Brandy Carr Road
- 2.2 –At the end turn left on Batley Road
- 2.3 – Turn right down Gawthorpe Lane following the Public Bridleway to Gawthorpe
- 2.5 – Pass under the M1
- 3.5 – Pass Highfield School and move on into High Street
- 3.9 – Turn right into Cross Street by The Shoulder of Mutton pub
- 4.0 – Turn left into Pickering Lane at the mini roundabout
- 4.2 – Turn right into Leeds Road and immediately right into Owl Lane
- 4.7 – Turn left into the Dewsbury Rams car park





## Stage 2 – Dewsbury Rams to Batley Bulldogs

- 0.0 – Head on up Owl Lane
- 0.2 – Head straight over the roundabout (2<sup>nd</sup> exit)
- 0.3 – At the lights, turn left on Leeds road and immediately right on High Street after the Shell Garage
- 1.1 – Follow the road round to the right by the School
- 1.3 – Pass under the via duct then take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit at the roundabout onto Alexandra Road (no through road for vehicles)
- 1.5 – At the end turn right on Bradford Road and immediately left up the hill on Taylor Street
- 1,8 – Turn left onto Purlwell Hall Road
- 1.9 – Turn left into Heritage Road
- 2.0 – Handover at Batley Bulldogs RLFC

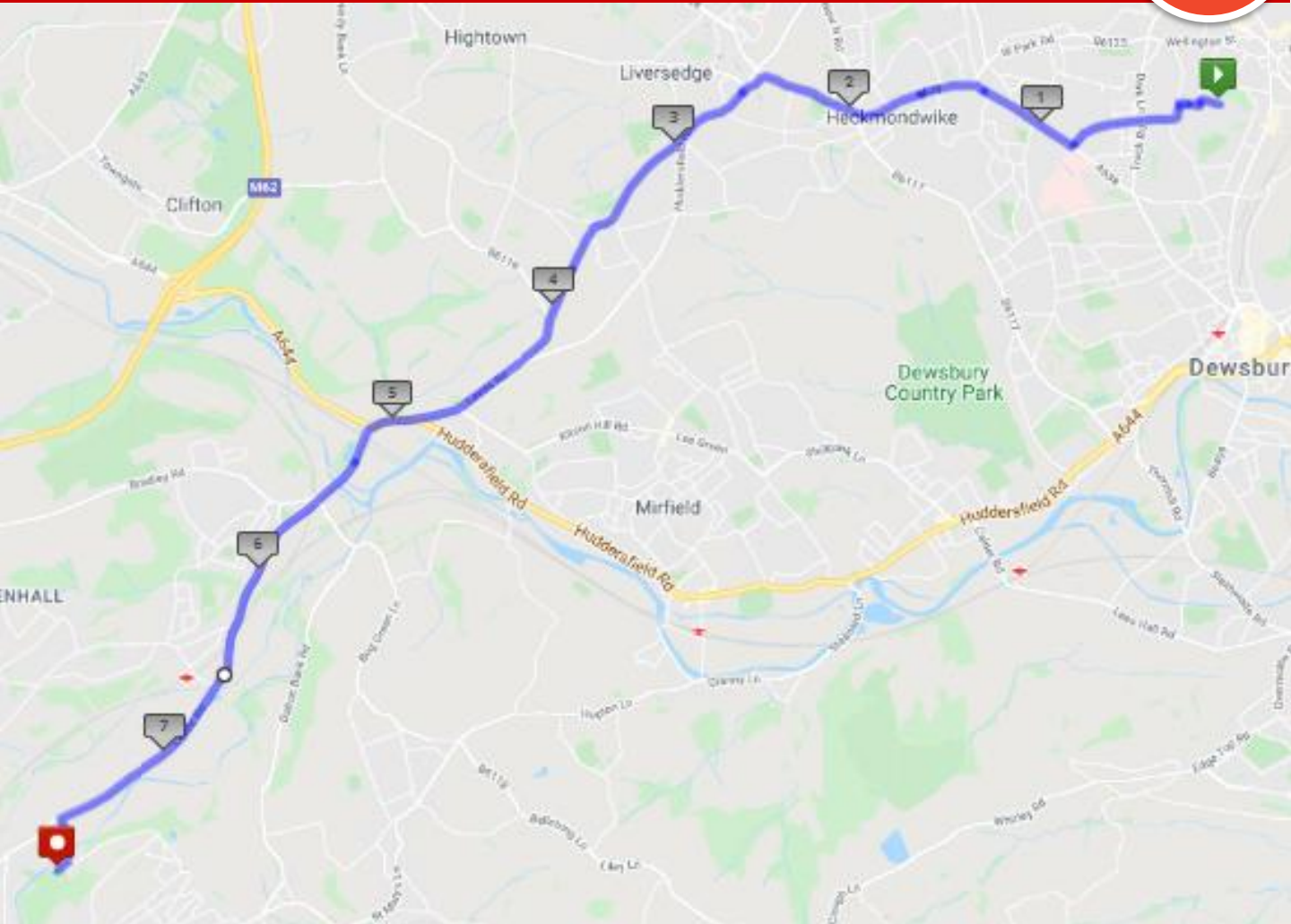




- 0.0 – Head back down Heritage Road
- 0.1 - At the end, turn left on Purlwell Hall Road and follow the road round to the right into Banks Street
- 0.2 – At the end, turn left on Purlwell Lane
- 0.4 – Cross straight over Track Road into Grangefield Avenue and follow this into Chapel Fold (No access for vehicles this way)
- 0.8 – At the end, turn right on Halifax Road
- 1.7 – Pass Heckmondwyke Grammar School
- 1.9 – Follow the round to the right in Heckmondwyke past the clock tower
- 2.4 – Turn left following signs to Huddersfield
- 2.5 – Turn left at the lights onto the A62 towards Huddersfield
- 3.0 – Fork right onto Roberttown Road
- 3.7 – Straight on past the Star Pub in Roberttown along Roberttown Road
- 4.3 – Turn right by the White Gate pub onto the A62 Leeds Road
- 4.9 – Straight on at the lights by the Three Nuns
- 5.1 – Take first exit at the roundabout onto Cooper Bridge Road
- 5.6 – Straight across the lights with Bradley Road
- 7.8– Cut across the Retail Park on the left following it down to Bradley Mills Road
- 7.9 – Turn left on Bradley Mills Road and arrive at the John Smith’s Stadium

# Stage 3– Batley Bulldogs to Huddersfield Town / Huddersfield Giants

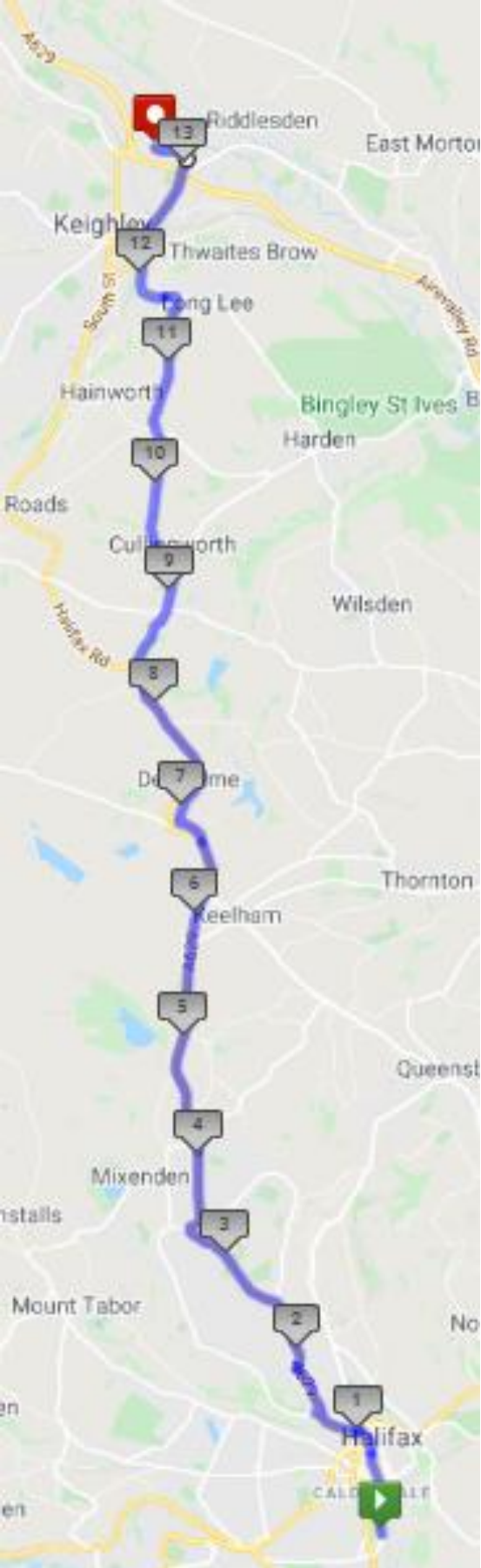


- 0.0 - Head away from the stadium up Stadium Way
- 0.3 – Head up Gasworks St and cross Leeds Rd into Lower Fitzwilliam St
- 0.7 – Veer right on right road then left on Viaduct Street by Mufflers
- 0.8 – Turn right through tunnel on Fitzwilliam St
- 1.0 – Turn right at the mini roundabout onto the A679 New N Road
- 2.5 – Pass the Cavalry Arms
- 3.1 – Take the first exit at Ainley Top roundabout and head up under the M62 – cross over to the other side for the pavement
- 3.5 – Head straight over the next roundabout onto Lindley Road through Blackley
- 3.9 – Pass Blackley Cricket Club
- 4.4 – Use the footpath to the right to cut the corner through the field and re-join the road at the end of the path heading down hill
- 4.7 – Cross Victoria Road into Hammerstones Road
- 4.9– As the road turns to the right turn left down Hullenedge Road
- 5.1 – Turn right at the bottom on Green Lane then next left on Queen Street
- 5.2 – At the bottom, turn right on Stainland Road and head through two sets of lights
- 6.2 – Head straight over the roundabout (2<sup>nd</sup> exit) and then merge with Huddersfield Road towards Halifax

- 7.0 – Straight through the lights by the hospital
- 7.5 – Fork right after the athletics field and pass the Bus Depot
- 7.6 – Arrive at the Shay

## Stage 4 – Huddersfield Town / Huddersfield Giants to Halifax Town / Halifax RLFC

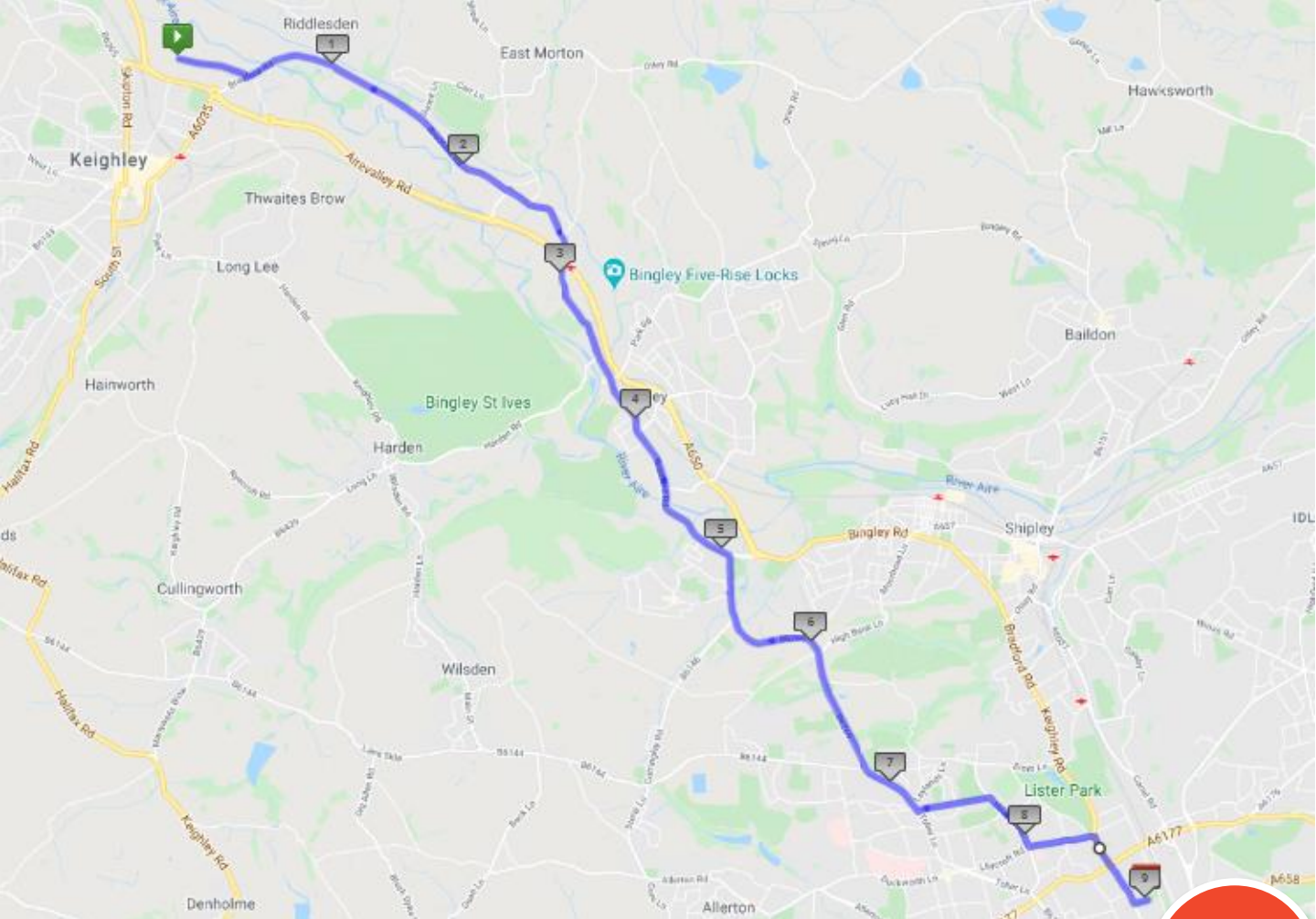


- 0.0 – Leave the Shay car park through the side exit and cross over Hunger Hill into Union Street
- 0.2 – Cross Prescott Street and continue heading straight on through the centre of Halifax
- 0.7 – Pass the library and the bus station and turn right at the end by Kashmiri Aroma onto Northgate
- 0.8 – Take the 2<sup>nd</sup> left down along Dean Clough and head under the flyover
- 1.2 – At the end, turn right on Shroggs Lane and then right at the lights onto Keighley Road
- 1.7 – Straight ahead at the lights with Ovenden Way
- 2.3 – Straight on at Ovenden Lights
- 3.1 – Pass Morrisons
- 3.5 – Pass the Fire Station
- 4.3 – Pass the Moorlands Pub
- 5.6 – Straight on at the lights with Thornton Road
- 7.3 – Pass through Denholme Village
- 8.3 – Turn right on Manywells Brow following the sign to Cullingworth
- 8.9 – Straight ahead by the Fleece Pub
- 9.2 – Pass the monument on right by monument at junction with Greenside Lane
- 9.3 – Turn left on Keighley Road towards Keighley (Pavements disappear so care needed)
- 10.4 – Straight over the crossroads by the closed down Guide Inn
- 11.6 – At the end, turn left and head down the hill
- 12.1 – Pass the Globe pub and pass under the bridge
- 12.4 – Turn right at the end of Coney Lane onto Bradford Road
- 13.0 – After Victoria Park, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit at the roundabout onto Alston Road
- 13.1 – At the end, turn left in Royd Ings Avenue
- 13.4 – Finish at Cougar Park

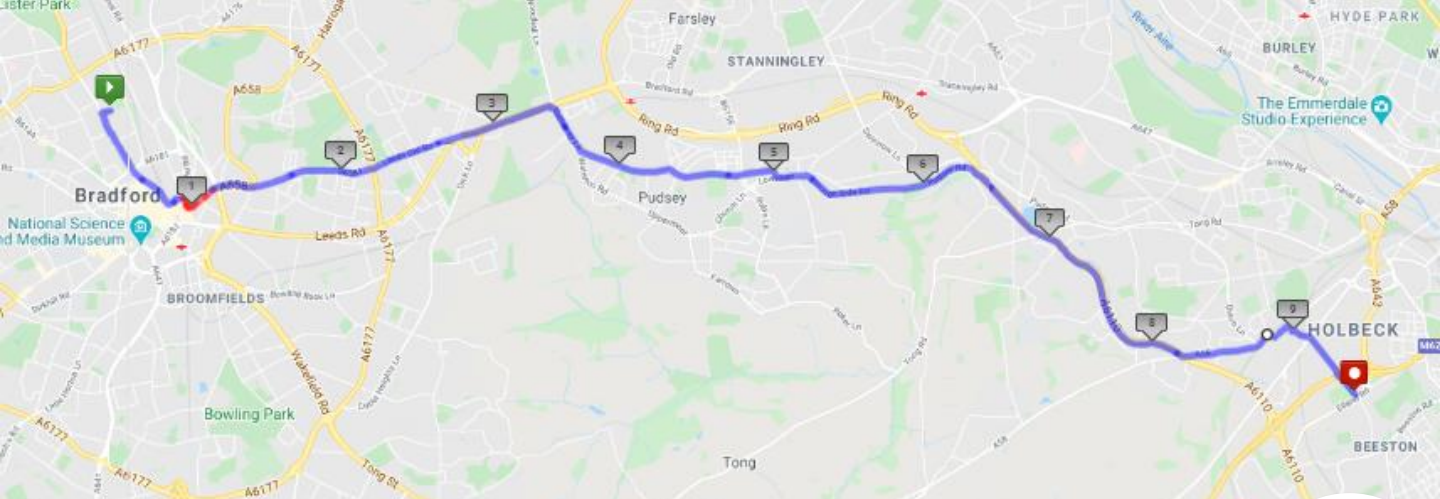
- 0.0 – Head back down Royd Ings Ave from whence you came
- 0.5 – At the end, turn left on Bradford Road
- 2.4 – Straight on at the roundabout by Homebase and Magnet
- 3.0 – Cross over the by-pass and pass Cross Flatts station
- 3.7 – Cross the lights in Bingley by Barclays Bank
- 4.5 – Pass Beckfoot School and the junction with Wagon Lane
- 5.1 – Turn right at the lights on Cottingley New Road towards Cottingley and Wilsden
- 5.6 – Straight on at double mini roundabout and then straight ahead again at the next mini roundabout
- 6.9 – Straight on at the lights onto Toller Lane passing the hand car wash
- 7.3 – Turn left onto Heaton Park Drive
- 7.7 – At the end, turn right on Heaton Road
- 8.1 – At the end at the lights, turn left down Oak Lane
- 8.5 – Turn right after Lister Park, onto Manningham Lane
- 9.0 – Turn left after the garage into Valley Parade and arrive at Bradford City

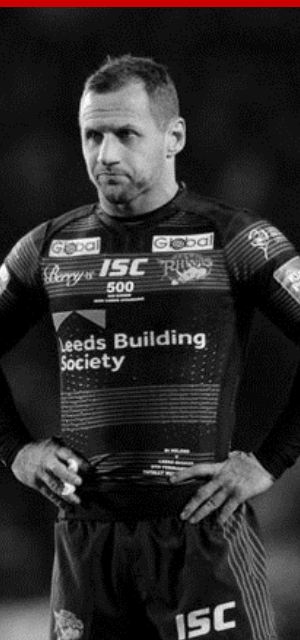

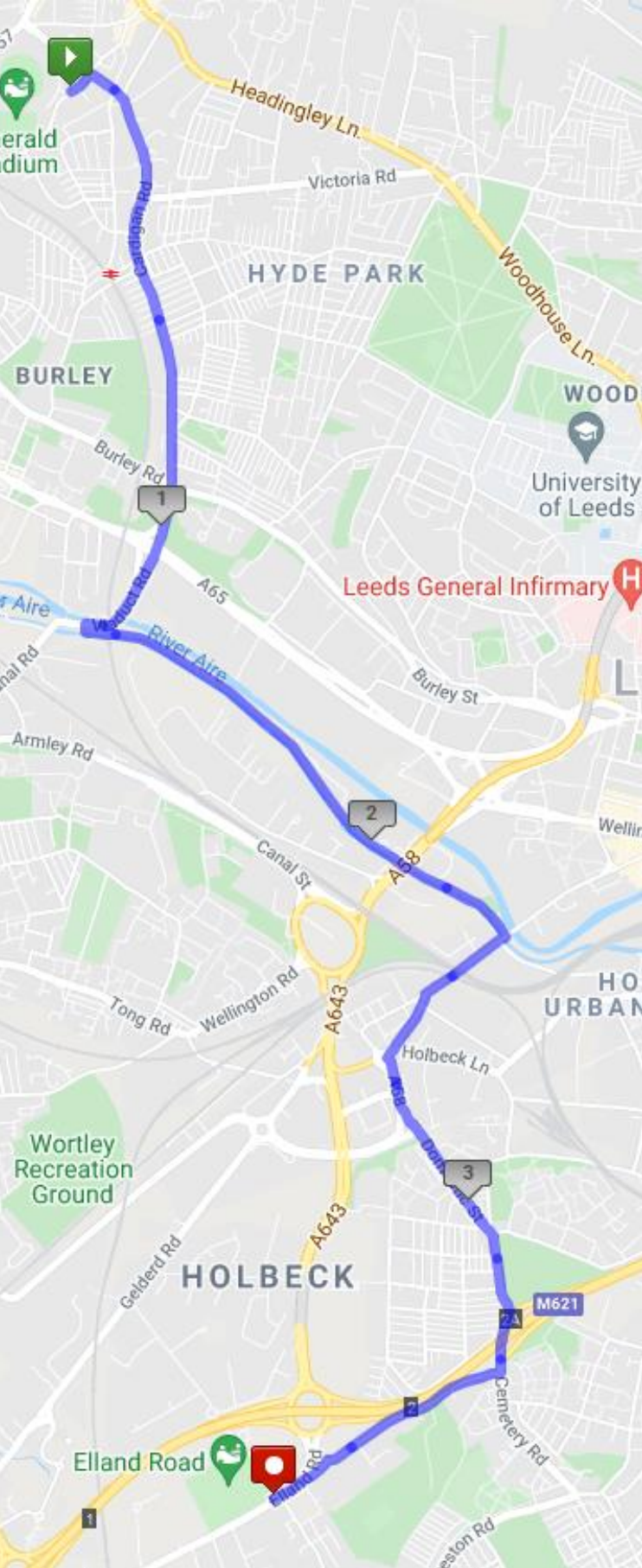


- 0.0 – Head up Valley Parade and turn left at the top on Manningham Road
- 0.5 – Straight on at the lights with Drewton Street towards the City Centre
- 0.8 – Turn left (1<sup>st</sup> exit) at the roundabout by the Midland Hotel onto Lower Kirkgate
- 0.9 – Turn right by M&S up Church Bank and follow the road round to the left
- 1.2 – Straight over the lights with the inner ring road up Barkerend Road
- 1.4 – Straight on (2<sup>nd</sup> exit) at the roundabout up Barkerend Road
- 2.2 – Straight across Killinghall Road by Habibs
- 2.7 – Pass McDonalds and go straight on that the big grassy roundabout on Bradford Road
- 3.4 – Straight across the roundabout by Thornbury Barracks
- 3.8 – Straight on (2<sup>nd</sup> exit) at the roundabout with Leeds Ring Road towards Stanningley
- 4.5 – Straight on at the double mini roundabout in Stanningley
- 5.1 – Turn left straight after Tesco Express and immediately right through the bollards heading up Leeds and Bradford Road
- 5.2 – On reaching the Primary School on the left, fork right onto Broad Lane
- 5.3 – Go through the bollards at the end, cross over Swinnow Lane and head straight on up Broad Lane
- 6.0 – Pass the zebra crossing
- 6.5 – Pass St Catherine's Mill
- 6.9 – Pass Spar supermarket
- 7.2 – Cross the canal, go straight through the lights into Wyther Lane, the veer right over the bridge at the next lights crossing over the river Aire
- 7.4 – Straight on at the lights by the Kirkstall Bridge Shopping Park
- 7.5 – Straight on at the lights with the A65 Abbey Road onto Kirkstall Lane
- 7.7 – At the lights by the newsagent, go straight on up Kirkstall Lane
- 8.1 – At the lights, turn right on St Ann's Lane and then take the first left on St Ann's Drive
- 8.4 – At the end, turn left along the single lane St Michael's Road
- 8.6 – Arrive at Headingley gates

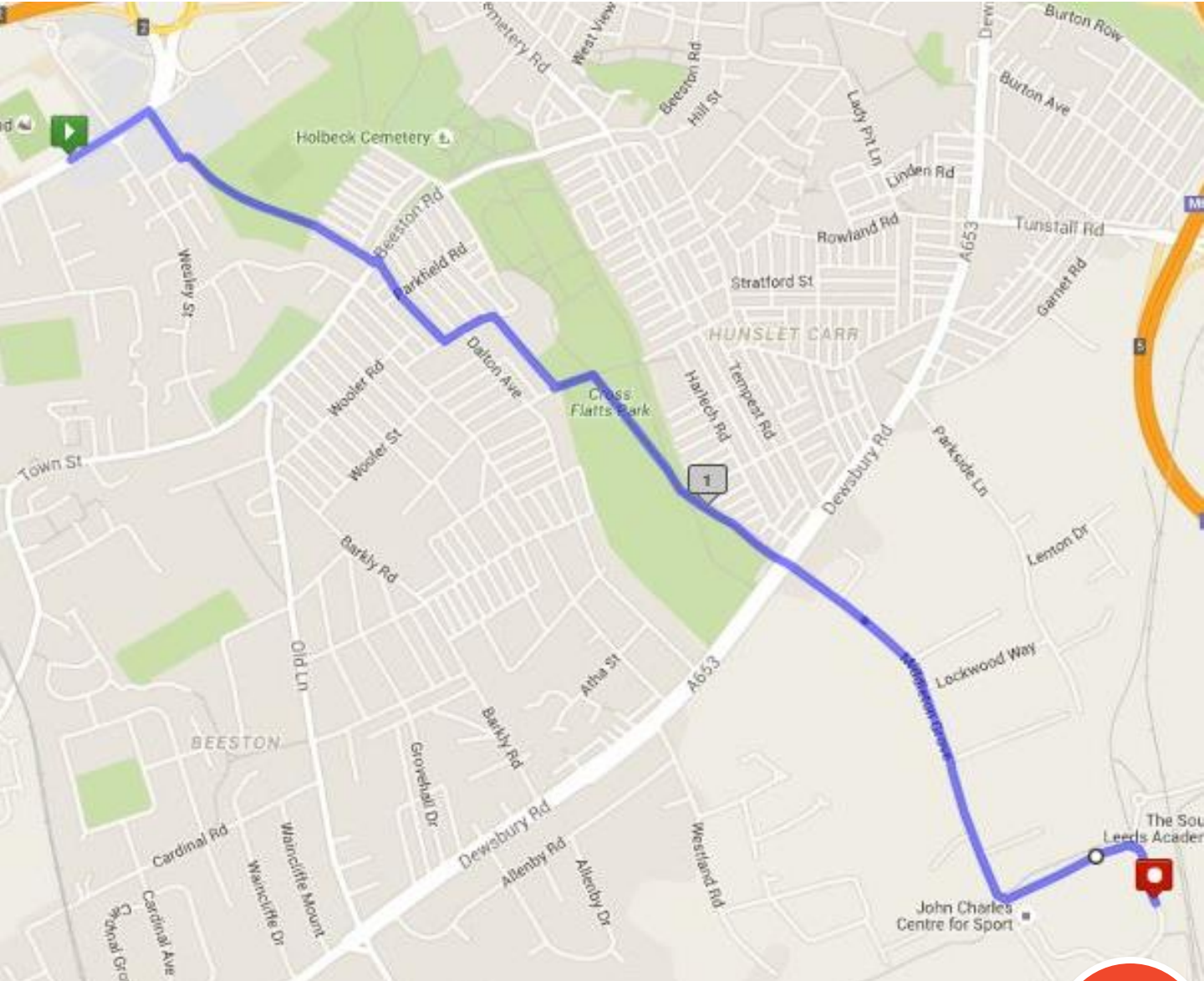


- 0.0 – Head back up St Michael's Road and turn right on Cardigan Road
- 0.8 – straight over the lights by Broadley's Decorators crossing to the left hand pavement
- 1.1 – Cross straight over the A65 into Viaduct Road
- 1.3 – Turn left on the path down to the canal and then turn left along the canal towpath
- 2.1 – Pass under the Inner Ring Road
- 2.3 – Head up the steps leaving the canal and then turn right on Whitehall Road
- 2.5 – Fork left on Springwell Street by post box and continue down no through road
- 2.6 – At the end by Fiat Garage, merge with Holbeck Lane and turn immediately left at roundabout
- 2.7 – Head straight on (1<sup>st</sup> exit) at roundabout on Domestic Street
- 3.1 – Straight over the mini roundabout keeping the park on the left
- 3.3 – Turn right on Cemetery Road and cross the M621
- 3.4 – Take first right on Elland Road after the M621 by the City Evangelical Church
- 3.8 – Keep left by the VW Garage and again by McDonalds staying on Elland Road
- 3.9 – Handover at Billy Bremner statue

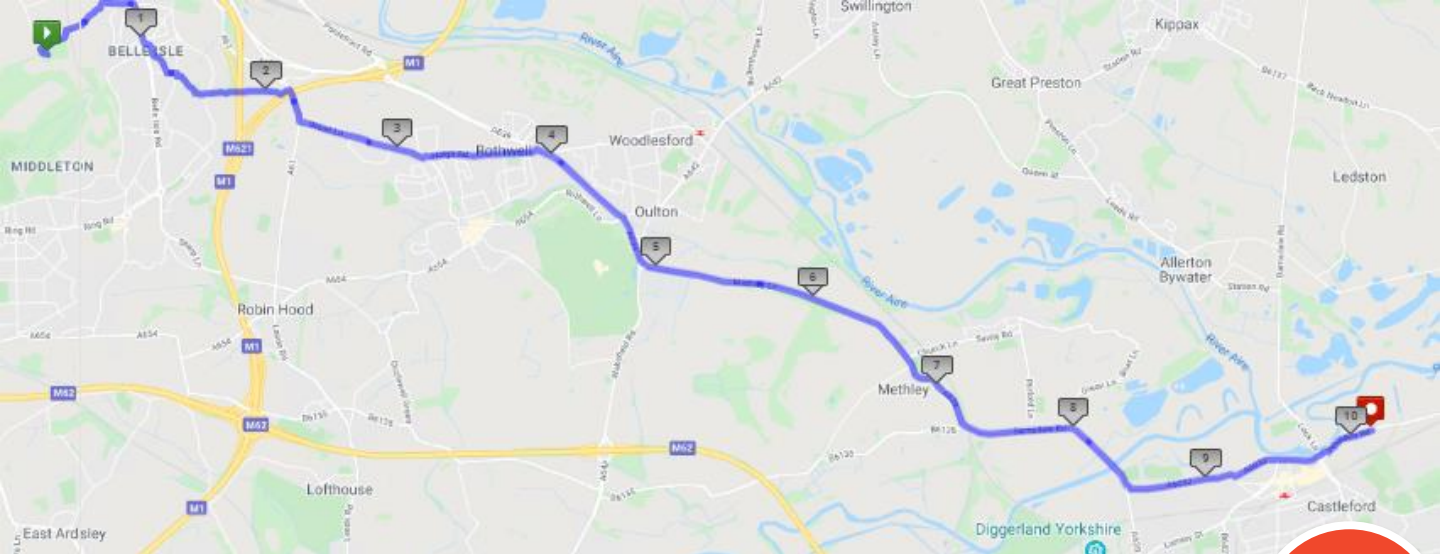

- 0.0 - Head back down Elland Road towards McDonalds and turn right up the road that leads to the entrance to it's car park
- 0.1 – At the top, turn left, go through the gate into the field and follow the path up the hill through the field
- 0.3 – At the end, go straight ahead into Marley Terrace
